### Show Information

Happy New Year and welcome to the Agility Nuts 2013/14 Winter League Series. We hope you and your dogs enjoy the show and we look forward to seeing at you at future Agility Nuts Shows. Please take the time to read through the following information as this will help to ensure that the show runs smoothly and finishes at a reasonable time.

**Walking the courses:** Courses at each level will be the same for all sizes of dogs. All handlers need to walk the course before the first class at their level, regardless of the height jumps are set at.

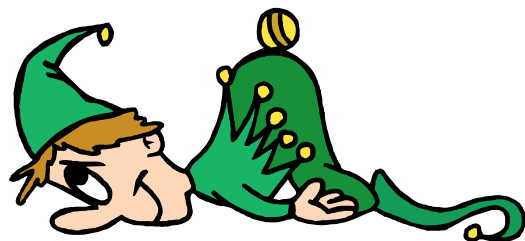
**Getting to the line:** Please be aware of when you need to run your dogs! If you have multiple dogs to run please stagger your runs to make sure that the end of the class is not delayed whilst the Judge waits for you to go and get your next dog. If you have a Tiny dog, please get your dogs to the line whilst people are still walking the course if the class starts with Tiny dogs (as indicated on the Ring Plan), or, if the class starts with Medium dogs, please bring your Tiny dogs to the ring whilst the Small dogs are running.

**Show Etiquette:** Please note that we now operate a policy of having **no more than 2 dogs off lead per person** in the exercise area at any one time. If you have multiple dogs running in the same class please spread your runs out during the class and avoid having all the dogs waiting for their runs ringside.

**NEW! Large and ABL Gundog Leagues.** This winter we are introducing 2 new leagues for gundogs at Agility Nuts shows. Details are on our website and on the show schedule, but if you want to be part of it, you need to let us know! If you have already indicated that you have a gundog (or gundog x gundog), it will be shown on your ring card (under the ring number and height of the dog). If you don't see "Gundog" on your ring card let us know asap and you will be added to the relevant league. Points are available in all classes except Nursery.

**NEW! Training in the ring.** If you would like to specifically train in the ring, you need to declare this before you start your run unless you declared it on your entry form. You **MUST** break the starting beam on entry into the ring and a whistle will blow after 45 seconds to indicate when you must leave the ring. Training rounds will not be judged.

**Don't forget to play your Jokers!** At each Agility Nuts show you get the opportunity to double the league points you gain from a single class by playing your Joker. You simply decide which class you want to play your joker in and let the ring party know when you book in. A coloured sticker will be placed on your scribe sheet to indicate that you are playing your joker. **You can only play ONE joker per dog at each show and you must declare that you are playing the joker BEFORE the run!** Anyone who plays more than one joker will have league points deducted!



**About the venue:** Trent Valley Equestrian Centre is a superb venue for handlers and dogs, so please make sure that you respect the following to ensure that we will be welcomed back in future years:

- The venue has a strict no smoking policy throughout the entire venue.
- Dogs must be kept on lead at all times except when competing or in the exercise area.
- Dogs must be kept under strict control in the exercise area.
- Dogs are not allowed in the toilets.
- Please pick up after your dogs. There will be black bin bags located by the exercise area and the entrance to the arena for you to dispose of any poo. Please do not dispose of poo in any other bins.

- The ménage next to the exercise area is out of bounds. Please try to keep your dogs off the ménage and definitely pick up after them if they foul the area.
- With the exception of the arena, the car park and the exercise area, all other areas are strictly out of bounds.
- Please ensure that you dispose of all litter in the bins provided.

**Parking:** Please park vehicles as directed. In the absence of anyone directing car parking, please park as indicated on the plan below.

**Dogs in cars:** It may be winter, but please remember that your dog is vulnerable and at risk if left in a vehicle at high temperatures. Please take care of your dog. If your dog is found to be at risk, forcible entry to your vehicle may be necessary without liability for the damage caused.

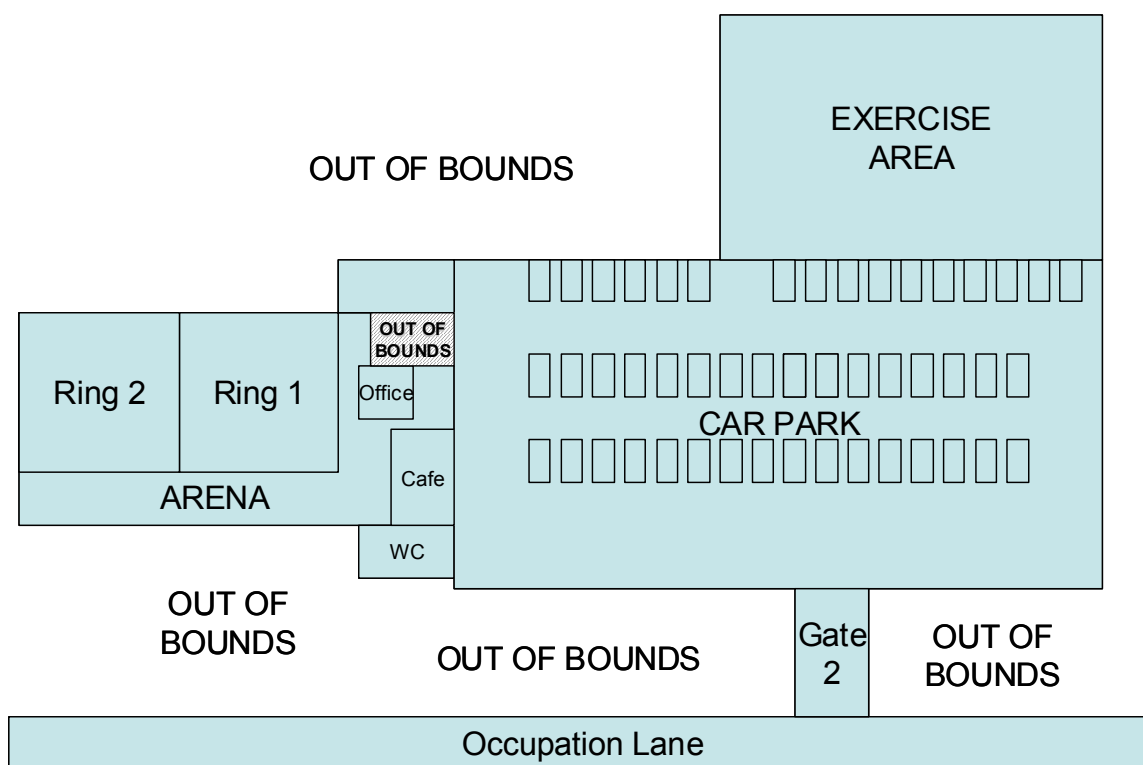
**Helping at the Show:** One of your ring cards will indicate which ring and when you are expected to help at the show. We ask that all competitors give 1 hour per day to help as specified to enable the smooth running of the show. Please report to your Ring Manager so that they can allocate a suitable job and time slot for you. Remember, no-one is expected to help at the expense of missing their classes. This is made a lot easier to achieve if everyone helps.

**Catering:** There is a café on site at the Equestrian Centre serving an excellent choice of hot and cold food at very reasonable prices. The café will be open all day.

**Results:** Agility Nuts will be using ringside entry of results with real-time updates of the current standings as each class runs available on monitor(s) located by the Show Office. Results and updated League Tables will be available on the Agility Nuts website ([www.agilitynuts.co.uk](http://www.agilitynuts.co.uk)) shortly after the show is over.

- Please park in orientation indicated – the cars parked immediately by the arena entrance belong to helpers arriving early to set up the show!
- All unshaded areas are strictly out of bounds.

#### Directions to the venue:

**Sat Nav users:** The postcode NG25 0TR pin-points the venue

#### From A1 (North or South)

- At Newark, take the A46 towards Leicester

- At the next roundabout take the 3rd exit onto the A617 (*signposted Mansfield*)
- After 2.8 miles turn left (*signposted Staythorpe, Rolleston, Fiskerton*)
- \*\*In Rolleston, turn right at the bend onto Station Road
- Turn left immediately after the level crossing onto Occupation Lane
- Enter the Equestrian Centre at Gate 2 on the right

**From A612 entering Southwell from the South/West**

- Turn right on to Westgate towards the centre of Southwell
- At the mini roundabout turn right onto Church Street (*signposted Newark*)
- Turn right onto Fiskerton Road (*signposted Fiskerton*)
- Turn left immediately before the level crossing onto Occupation Lane
- Enter the Equestrian Centre at Gate 2 on the left
